The American Chocolate Fund for the A. E. F. in France closed its work shortly after the Armistice was signed, November 11th 1918. 36 tons of chocolate was shipped overseas through the American Red Cross. Chocolate was supplied to the Submarine Chasers in our Atlantic Ports, to the Aviation Camp on Long Island, to our army transports carrying our A. E. F. to France, and also on the transports bringing home our wounded soldiers, to the Navy Club, and to many of our hospitals where our wounded soldiers were being cared for in this Country. The inclosed letters will explain what disposal was made of the money on hand when the American Chocolate Fund finished its work.
