Dear Miss Tarbell:

Your second telegram is here and I thank you for your willingness to take care of the Akron proposition with me. Will you be good enough to let me know where you will come from to our opening date. Will you be coming from Chicago, or from Philadelphia, or from New York? I will send you complete and detailed instructions about the railroad route and all, as soon as I know where you wish to have us route you from.

We will plan on your being in Akron by nine A.M. on June 14th, then after the address to the University at ten, I believe we can put in the day pleasantly, and either get to Niles for the afternoon or evening, and I am very certain it will be for the evening performance, for I do not think there is any connection to make it for the afternoon. I think, however, the roads are good and we could drive in a new auto which I will have by that time, and we could easily make the journey in two hours from Akron to Niles. If you prefer to speak in the afternoon at Niles, we can follow the program as arranged.

I do not know whether you have seen one of our <sup>yes I have</sup> programs or not. I am mailing one herewith. I do not happen to have one of Niles, Ohio, but this is the ~~same~~ day, where you will appear, and you will see by the enclosed list just the days on which you will appear in all the towns on the Circuit.
