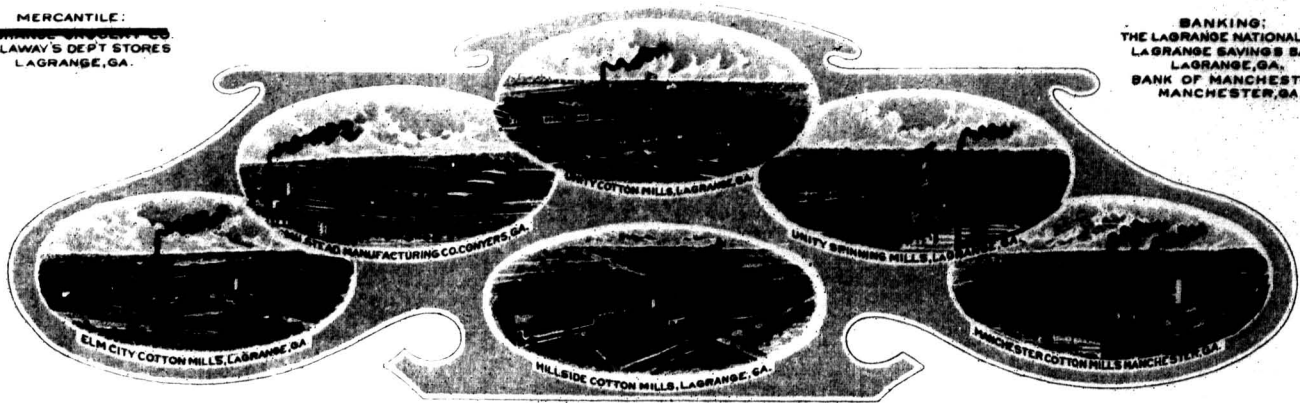

Dear Miss Tarbell:

Your favor of the 6th instant to Mr. Fuller E. Callaway, enclosing the manuscript, was received in his absence on business in the East. Instead of returning home he has gone to Baltimore, where he has placed himself under charge of Dr. Lewellys F. Barker, of Johns Hopkins, for an indefinite stay. We are glad to be able to say that Mr. Callaway does not seem to have any organic trouble, but is very much jaded and worn from his many years of strenuous work and, as he puts it, this is like "running the old car into the garage for a thorough overhauling."

A part of the plan is that for the time being Mr. Callaway is to have absolute freedom from all business and personal concerns, so we will not be able to refer the article to him.

We have gone over it here, and are sending it herewith with a few minor changes indicated by way of suggestion.
