Dear Miss Tarbell:

Long to hear of  
your sister's illness - We  
are all of us more or less  
"under" the spell of grief that  
this war - I began to feel it  
this morning. Sincerely hope you  
are well and not tired out.  
I wish very much that I could  
be of personal service at any  
time and that you would call  
upon me for any such service.  
A man sometimes looks back  
into some problem "when angels  
fear to tread!" It has happened  
that the temporary cessation of  
lessons was tried for me as  
I have been overwhelmed by  
my school duties. Glad to return
