Mrs. Wilkes has called to our attention the letter from the Wisconsin State Association Opposed to Woman Suffrage.

In replying to it you may perhaps wish to have further information as to the status of the Wisconsin State Division of the Woman's Committee.

1. We have had no notification that Mrs. Morgan has resigned and we consider her one of the most able chairmen in any of the State Divisions.
2. Wisconsin is listed as among the very first of our State Divisions both as to intensive organization, and the intelligence, vigor and originality of the programs which have been carried out.
3. The Americanization program in Wisconsin has been especially comprehensive , and the program outlined for Milwaukee, a particularly difficult community for such work, has elicited both interest and admiration here at headquarters.
