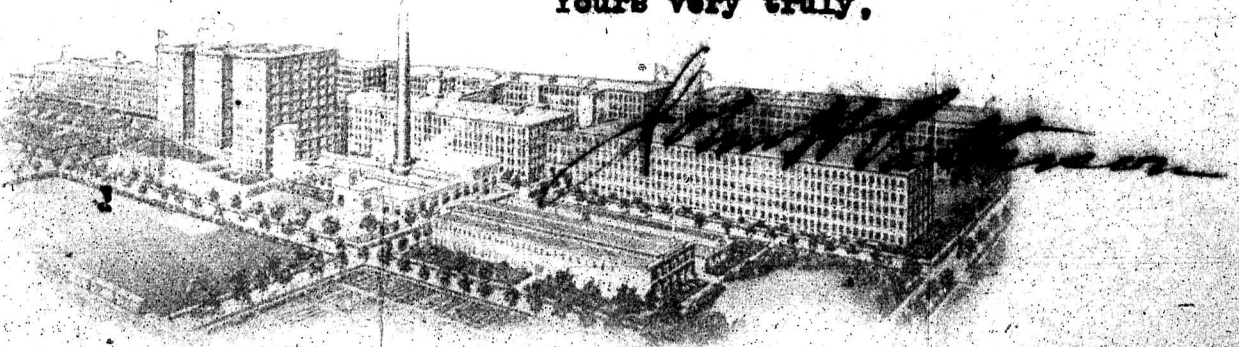
Dear Miss Blair:
