2) The picture opposite Page 130, in "The Dramatic Life of Abraham Lincoln" is from a scene in the photo play.

3) Page 68 of Heroic Statues is the best conception of the young Lincoln, that is of the Anne Rutledge period that I know of

If you can get your hand on a file of The Century Life of Lincoln, published in the '80's you might find something. My recollection is that they had two or three very good wood cuts by good illustrators of the young Lincoln. I am sorry my file is not available.
