W. W. Ellsworth, formerly of the Century, sent me the photographs. He got hold of them in 1909, through an assistant attorney-general, T. D. McGregor of Kentucky.

The church has been in continuous use since 1816, that is, it was there when Thomas Lincoln and his family moved into Indiana. An article in the New York Times last fall - sometime in October - I think, shows this church has been running continuously. The records that Ellsworth quotes in this article are as follows:
