

This shall oblige me my heirs & to make a deed to A&R Steele for 500 acres of land laying in Shelby County and adjoining Benjamin Huse five hundred acre survey On a branch of Jephthas creek near Jephthas mountain and patented in my name on the 7th day of Octo. 1786. It is to be remembered that when the deed is made that I am not to be accountable for any of the land if all or any part should be lost that I only sell my right without recourse to me or my heirs it being for value recd. As witness my hand and seal this first day of September 1798
