Republicans Attention!

The following will be the order of proceeding at the meeting between Hon. A. Lincoln and Hon. S. A. Douglass.

Mr Lincoln is expected to arrive on the special train from Chicago. He will be met at the depot by the committee and Republicans en masse and will be received with a salute of thirteen guns. The Republican citizens will be then formed in procession and escort Mr Lincoln through the principal streets to the residence of Hon. J. O. Glover. The following named persons are appointed marshals and they will meet the various delegations on reaching town and assign them their place in the procession:
