In reply to your inquiry of August 14th, relative to information about Mordecai Lincoln in Monmouth County, I would say that I have nothing except the reference in Edwin Salter's history of Monmouth and Ocean Counties, on page XXXVIII in the Genealogical record at the back of the book.
