Dear Madam Several years ago I sent you a copy of an autograph letter signed, which I owned, written by Abraham Lincoln, and which you desired to use in a second edition of your biography. Since that time, in fact, recently, I have bought another very interesting ABS 3P. 8vo. of his, of which I enclose a rough copy, thinking you might like to have it. The original was given, during the war, by my grand. to a friend of his, who had asked him for a souvenir of the Pres. This friend put it in his safe, among his keepsakes, & in this way it came on the death of the friend, to his son - This son, one of my neighbors, sold it to me - I think it safe to say it has never been published, & you are practically the first one to see it - Hope it will interest you - I would be glad to know if this letter reaches you
