

MEMORANDUM

November 12, 1924.

Judge Gary's personal library of law books, including leather-bound volumes containing his arguments before the Superior Court and the Appellate Court of Illinois, was given to the Illinois Steel Company under an agreement that they should keep the library in good condition and up to date. He is contemplating, however, requesting Mr. Buffington to send to him here all the volumes containing his own arguments.

The library of books supplied to the Northwestern University, now known as the "Elbert H. Gary Library of Law", consisted of new volumes purchased for this purpose.
