Dear Miss Hoxie:

Miss Tarbell suggests that you send us Chapter III in order that we can transfer to it extra references as well as the additions which you ask and the correction which Dr. Schlesinger asked in a letter of November 8th - the latter a contradiction in dates on Pages 33 and 65. If you can send me this Chapter I will make the corrections and return to you immediately.

In your letter of November 27th you ask for a footnote for the reference on Page 54, Chapter II to Mr. H. A. DeLand (Note spelling) in Florida. It should be placed at the end of the second paragraph, that is at the end of the sentence reading, "Unlike most promoters he met the obligation, etc. The footnote will read:- Information given author in an interview in 1926 with Dr. Lincoln Hulley President of John B. Stetson University at DeLand, Florida.

In Dr. Schlesinger's letter of November 30th he asks for the immediate return of Chapter VII and VIII. I am mailing them to you today with a few changes that Miss Tarbell has made together with the unnumbered Chapter, "Reforming from Within."

So far I have been unable to locate the first name of Hoxie - Page 223, Chapter VIII. Also the initials of the Judge Gary who presided at the trial of the Chicago anarchists - Page 245. I hope to get these at once and will send them to you.
