Dear Miss Chandler:

Coming in from the country yesterday I found on my desk your note of December 27th with the material from the test men. It is quite adequate so far as the system itself is concerned. If I find I am wanting a bit additional - some specific points I will call again.

As to the message which Mr. Young was to have given I should like to know more about it. You spoke of his interest in having a fac-simile of a document prepared to give to the Test Boys as a souvenir of the dinner. It could not have been of the Morgan letter - the "chalked hat" letter, as I have a letter from Mr. Morgan himself saying he believed the original was destroyed in the Chicago fire. I hope we can get the whole story - it is excellent.
