Long experience in the trade had taught these women to calculate closely the number of dresses they could make in a week and the amount they could earn. Based upon definite statements by the workers, a fair estimate of weekly earnings for 107 women showed that half earned less than \$2, a third from \$2 to \$3, and only one woman as much as \$5. The hourly estimated earnings of 89 women ranged from about 1 to 11½ cents, well over two fifths earning less than 4 cents.

One woman unusually fast and skilful in making children's silk dresses, embroidered and lace trimmed, had to work steadily at least 8½ hours daily for 4 days to make a dozen dresses, for which she was paid \$1.75, or less than 15 cents a dress.

In another family two sisters, by steady work, could turn out in a week 20 machine-stitched dresses with hand fagoting, earning together only \$3. A couple of women, makers of a very fine style of infants' wear, could not earn more than 42 cents for a long day's work.

In no case was embroidery considered as "pick-up work" or a casual diversion. This type of work provided the only source of income in many families. Housekeeping interfered but little with the routine of sewing, and woman after woman described the steadiness and regularity of her sewing hours, necessary in many instances to keep the wold from the door.

"I work from 8 a.m. to about 10 p.m.—rest 1 hour at twilight—don't stop for anything—mother does all the housework," one girl said. "I make from 1½ to 2 dozen dresses a week, sowing all I can, getting 70 cents a dozen, or about 3 cents an hour," another stated.

Speed as well as skill was essential to meet the demands of the New York contractors that orders be filled rapidly despite the low pay. One Texas employer on complaining to the New York office of the unfair and greatly reduced rates for the workers, was told, "You must compete with the cheap Puerto Rican labor or lose the contract."

Conditions in this trade are strikingly similar in Texas and Puerto Rico—with the contract system, home work, and low wages prevailing in both places, the Women's Bureau points out. "Both localities, although remote from the centers of the industry, are competitors of factories located elsewhere and undoubtedly cause low wages in New York and Connecticut."
