Abraham Lincoln left no will. His property which totaled when it was settled in 1866 \$110, 974.62 was divided between his three heirs - Mrs. Lincoln - Robert Lincoln - Thomas Lincoln.

If your correspondent wants to know more of the matter he will find all that I know in an article published in The American Magazine for February 1924 and reprinted in the Appendix to the second volume of the last edition of my Life of Abraham Lincoln, published in 1928 by the Macmillan Company.
