An original print from the last Springfield photograph of the president elect before his departure for Washington. The present print was made in 1874 from the original negative upon which the varnish was cracked and discolored. The print was made for the private collection of James M. Richardson.

Reserve photograph No. 34. The Reserve photograph reproduced in reduced size only a portion of the photograph, 1 3/4 x 2 1/2. Reserve says: "This portrait was regarded by Mr. Lincoln's neighbors as his best likeness and was used as the basis for the painting in the Springfield Capitol.
