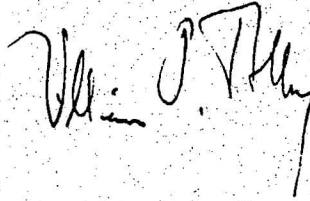
Dear Miss Tarbell:
