Jan 7th 1865

Dear Del,

I have not written for nearly a week as we have been moveing (sic) and the wether (sic) very cold. We are now well fixed for cold wether (sic) and I expect to be able to write to you quite often. The men are very busy building quarters for the winter and our camp has already assumed the appearance of a western town. I recieved (sic) a real good letter from you today and will answer it tomorrow as I have not time to write any thing worthy the name before the mail goes out which will be in a few minutes, The letter I recieved (sic) today was written on New Years Eve. We belong to the 3rd Brigade, 2nd Div. Cav. Corps H.P. (?) The 6th Ohio Cav. is in the same Brigade which makes it very pleasant. The mail is read (sic) and I must stop will write tomorrow. I send you lots of love and plenty of kisses.
