

Head Ins 12th, O. V. Cav
Jan 7th 1865

Dear Del,

I have not written for nearly a week as we have been moving and the weather very cold. We are now well fixed for cold weather and I expect to be able to write to you quite often. The men are very busy building quarters for the winter, and our camp has already assumed the appearance of a western town. I received a real good letter from you to day and will answer it tomorrow as I have not time to write any thing worthy the name before the mail goes, but which will be in a few minutes. The letter I received to day was written on New Years eve. We belong to the 2nd Brigade 1st Div Cavalry Corps A.P. The 6th Ohio Cavalry is in the same Brigade which makes it very pleasant. The mail is read and I must stop will write to morrow.
