Miss Thomas lives in East McKeesport, Pa. Her major is English and she is interested in going into publishing. She is also a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma.

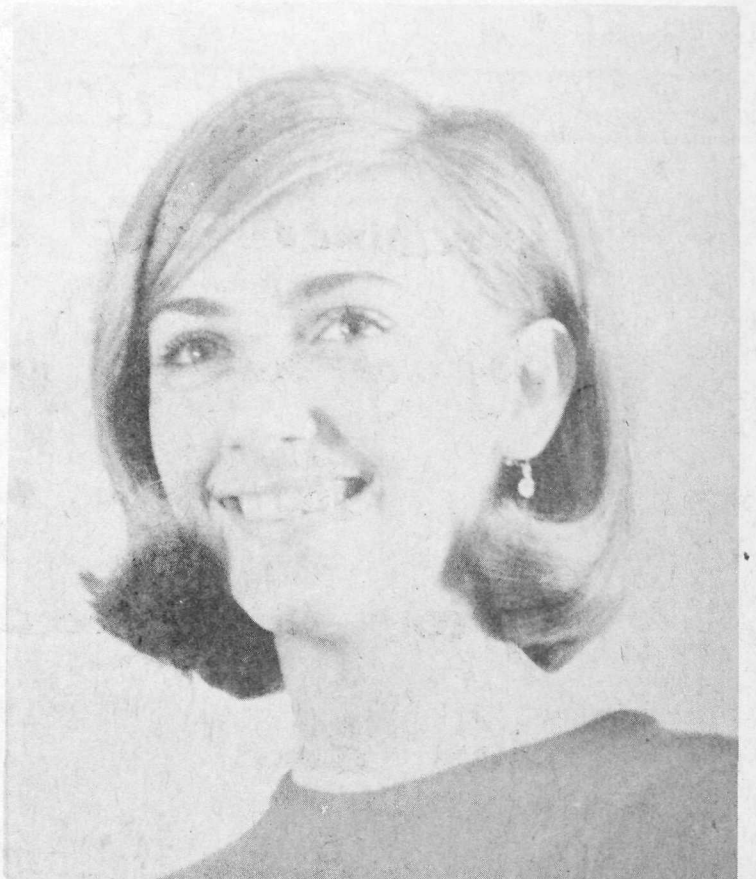
