

Soldiers Home June 24th/63

Dear Brother

I received your letter
some time ago but not having
much time I did not answer
it day before Yesterday we
left The City ~~and~~ at 3 o'clock
in the P.M. we marched to
Soldiers Home followed by six
6 horse teams all mules 3 four
hore teams come an hour or two
afterwards Yesterday 5 more
teams come with wood that
we had left behind our tent
did not come till yesterday all
the rest ^{of their tents} come the same day
we moved we got our tent
up then before the most of them
and when it was done was
better There was forty Cavalry

Come up with the The
President - a big thing
on oil creek Twenty or more
come up at a quar & every
night and Morning go
down with him We are
not Camped in the same
Place we were before we
are about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile
south west of the old camp
we all have good times here
and are all well we are
in camp at a nice place
for to see in the City
and down the Potomac
last Sunday there was a
big Cavalry fight with some
artillery which was heard in
the City

I got Jim letter the other
day nothing more at Present
from Your Brother
