Gentlemen:

I write you with reference to the dates of Miss Tarbell, so there will be no misunderstanding in any way. Here are the dates as they stand for her at present:

Now I think Miss Tarbell understands that the Dixie Bureau is to use some dates in March and that she is to go from Dixie territory to the Mutual territory, filling a few dates for the Mutual after those of the Dixie.

I do not know whether Miss Tarbell feels her strength will be enough so she could go on over to the Dixie Bureau after the Alkahest dates, or not, or whether both Dixie and Mutual Bureaus could use February time. I hope both of you will take this up at once and see whether you could use February time, in case Miss Tarbell could give you the weeks of February 11 and 18. I am writing her asking that she write each of you, saying whether she prefers to go on from Alkahest territory and fill these dates, or go back home and start again for the Dixie and Mutual dates.

I trust this can be settled very soon for the benefit of all concerned.
