Dear Mr. Sites:

In looking over the Gary genealogy, I find that on page 88 it is stated that when Erastus Gary migrated to Illinois in the fall of 1638 there went with him Jesse C. Wheaton and Warren L. Wheaton.

If I understand Judge Gary's notes as well as what he has told me in conversation, Erastus Gary went alone to Illinois and the Wheatons followed the next year. Am I or am I not right?

In the notes on the Vallette family which you turned over to me there is no mention of the Vallette who came to this country from France as an officer in Lafayette's army, as I find on page 3, line 3 of Judge Gary's biographical notes. This matter may be cleared up in the Vallette genealogy of which you spoke yesterday.

I am depending upon you to let me know the hour of my Friday interview with Mr. Buffington.
