Mayor Hanke of Chester  
In the reign of Elizabeth (1584) he was  
granted the right of arms (see Burke)  
which were also borne by his son:

Note: Margaret Williams  
was born 4 Dec. 25, 1721.  
(June)  
she was 63 in 1784  
a widow in 1781.

John Hanke, of Ilkerton, Derbyshire, Eng., Gentleman.  
This house, friends of young William Penn, became  
members of the Society of Friends; they secured  
all titles of honor, family insignia, etc.

1. Luke Hanke (1st generation in America)  
(1634-1701)  
of Eastwood, Nottinghamshire, Eng.  
and Darby, Chester Co. Penn.  
A member of Chesterfield Monthly and Breach  
to America 1682, returned  
to Eng. 1693; buried at Breach.

2. John Hanke (may have been older than  
(16- -1679) (called John I. by A.E.C.) [ Luke)  
of Ilkerton, Derbyshire, Eng.  
Referred to in Pesse's "Sufferings  
of the Quakers," but dates confused.  
A member of Breach Meeting and  
Chesterfield Monthly Meeting  
— M. Margaret (?)
