My dear President Britt:

Pardon the delay in replying to your note of September 22nd - I have been out of town for ten days and all my mail is seriously delayed.

You call my attention to the fact that in my letter of September 14 I spoke of beginning my term at Knox on the 15th of October. That was a misprint. It is impossible for me to get away from here before November. I want to begin my work there early enough so that I can finish the six weeks and get back here comfortable for Christmas. I don't see how I can do that unless I begin on say the 8th of November. I could leave on the evening of the 6th or 7th.

After your great celebration of next Saturday and Sunday is over, will you not drop me a line, telling me just what will be most satisfactory to you? I want to get in the full period without pressure at either end. The only difficulty is that I don't know of what date your winter term ends.
